## <u>Assessment</u>

In addition to their Ministry requirements, our students will be assessed in 8 International Baccalaureate subject areas and an interdisciplinary unit.

Each subject area has a set of criteria by which they are assessed (a table is provided below). At the end of the MYP 1-4 years (secondary 1-4), students will be issued an IB report card. There is also an IB progress report issued at the same time as the term 2 report card.

MYP 5 (secondary 5 students) have additional requirements. All MYP 5 students must complete a Personal Project. Additionally, students following the enriched path will need to complete the following elements in order to be eligible for the Official IB certificate:

- E Portfolios in Language Acquisition (French) and Physical and Health Education.
- Completed and passed On-screen exams in Mathematics, Language and Literature (English), Language Acquisition (French), Science, Individuals and Societies (Integrated Humanities) and Interdisciplinary. If they meet the requirements of the certificate (a minimum of 3 in each subject and a total of 28 marks) they will receive their certificate at graduation in October.
