At Lakeside Academy, the International Baccalaureate Middle Years Programme offers an opportunity for students to broaden their scope of intellectual pursuits with opportunities to explore social and global issues.

Every MYP 5 student must complete the Personal Project in order to obtain their IB certificate. This is a lengthy project that brings together all the aspects of their journey as an IB learner.

This project involves students creating a product that reflects something that they are passionate about. They must also identify a learning goal that will be achieved by doing this project.

Typically, the personal project begins towards the end of the MYP 4 year. An information session is offered to answer questions. Each student will have a mentor who will help guide them. The project is handed in during the month of December of the MYP 5 year.
